Why? **Your Child's Life is Worth it!**

Sudden Cardiac Arrest is the leading cause of death on school campuses.

SCA is caused by an abnormality in the heart's electrical system or structure that abruptly stops the heartbeat. The American Heart Association reports that every 3 days in the U.S., a young athlete dies from sudden cardiac arrest. In 80% of cases, SCA was the first symptom. The threat is real.

Cardiovascular testing can help save students' lives.

We are partnering with Wimbledon Athletics to provide EKG and echocardiography testing to detect heart conditions that can cause sudden cardiac arrest and vascular ultrasound to identify vascular conditions common to athletes (such as blood clots). Early detection is the best prevention!

This potentially life-saving testing is affordable!

There are no upfront costs for the testing. Wimbledon Health Partners will bill your health insurance for the testing, accepting what your carrier deems usual and customary. If applicable, WHP will bill the policyholder for deductible and co-insurance, as required by law. **There are a number of circumstances that would waive any deductible or co-insurance owed, including saving for college.**

THE PPE IS NOT ENOUGH

- Published studies estimate PPEs catch only 3-15% of cardiac problems
- The majority of students do not exhibit recognizable symptoms
- Many heart conditions are inherited, but parents themselves may be unaware they have the gene

EARLY DETECTION IS KEY

- Preventative testing can detect cardiovascular conditions before something happens
- Awareness of potential issues allows you to be proactive so measures can be taken to manage, monitor, treat, or cure a condition
